Plastic Injection Set-Up and Processing Technician

Position Summary:

This position sets-up, process, and repairs plastic injection machines to produce plastic parts to specifications as production processes define. This position may also work in a warehouse or other plant environments.

EDUCATION AND/OR EXPERIENCE:

- High School Diploma or GED
- Three or more years operating, setting up, maintaining, and repairing plastic injection molding machines.

QUALIFICATIONS (knowledge, skills, abilities required):

1. Must possess basic reading, writing, and computation skills.
2. Ability to continuously improve and learn new skills.
3. Ability to read and comprehend blueprints.
4. Experience with calipers, tape measurers and other measuring device.
5. Must possess good manual dexterity and hand-eye coordination.
6. Ability to work effectively in a fast-paced environment.
7. Ability to work with minimal supervision.
8. Ability to work collaboratively and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers.
9. Ability to effectively problem-solve.
10. Good communication and interpersonal skills.
11. Forklift experience- optional but willing to learn.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

1. Performs machine set-up, operation, adjustments and maintenance on plastic injection molding machines and other assigned equipment.
2. Experienced with trouble-shooting and repairing plastic injection molding machines.
3. Develops new processes and improves processes to ensure part quality as required.
4. Designs and verifies tools as required.
5. Leads and participates in problem solving activities.
6. Provides technical guidance and advice to other employees.
7. May support other teams as required.

Other duties may be assigned.

LANGUAGE SKILLS:

Ability to read, write, verbalize and comprehend instructions and correspondence. Ability to effectively present information in one-on-one and group situations to team members and customers as job duties require. Conflict resolution. Good interpersonal skills.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS:

Must have basic computation skills.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS:

While performing the duties of this job, the team member is continuously standing, repetitively grasping and repetitively using fine manipulation with the hands. The team member may be frequently required to walk, bend, squat, or twist as well as repetitively push or pull. The team member may be required to lift up to 60 pounds multiple times in a 10- hour shift and constantly lift up to 5 pounds continuously. Occasional lifting overhead may be necessary.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

This position is performed in a shop environment. Team members in this position may be exposed to loud operating machinery, cold temperatures, chemicals and vapors. The team member may occasionally be required to work in an office environment.
